

Re- commencement of Academic Instructions to the students of the Faculty of Law

1. Due to the prevailing situation in the country, all students are requested to cooperate with the security measures adopted by the University of Colombo in order to provide a safe and conducive environment for the academic activities of the Faculty of Law.
2. No member of academic and non-academic staff, students or visitors are allowed to enter the university /Faculty premises without verification as to their identity, reasons for visit and subject to physical body check and checking of all bags, baggage and back-packs or any of their other belongings.
3. The newly opened main gate in front of the Library has been designated as the Main Entrance to the Faculty of Law. Therefore, students are requested to produce their **valid University Identity Card** at the entrance and cooperate with the security officers in verifying their identity. No student will be permitted, under whatever circumstances, to enter the University/Faculty premises without the **valid University Identity Card**.
4. No vehicles belonging to students whether cycles, motorbikes, scooters or three – wheelers, would be allowed to enter the University/Faculty premises without a valid vehicle pass obtained from the Student and Staff Welfare Branch of the University of Colombo (situated in the College House). All vehicles referred to above are subject to thorough check at the Main Gate of the Faculty.
5. All students are requested to wear their Student Identity Card at all times while there are within the University/Faculty premises.
6. No person is allowed to enter or stay within the Faculty premises with their faced covered.
7. Excluding the face cover, rest of dress code that includes the head, ear and neck cover, must be considered as personal decision of the person concerned.
8. No students will be allowed to remain inside the Lecture Halls after 05.00 p.m.
9. Only the registered students and persons authorized by the Vice Chancellor are allowed to enter or stay in hostels.
10. No visitors of students or any other persons are allowed visiting hostels.
11. Hand Bags /back-packs are strictly prohibited inside the Lecture Halls, Examination Halls, and Laboratories.
12. Students are discouraged from bringing Bags /back-packs to the canteen.

13. Cloak-room facilities have been made in the Faculty premises for safe-keeping the students' handbags and other bags which are not allowed inside the Lecture Halls.
