Eligibility

- Applicants must be **undergraduate students enrolled at the Faculty of Law, University of Colombo**.
- Preference may be given to students in their **senior years of study (Academic Year III and IV)**
- Applicants should have a strong interest and background in **legal research**.

Nature of Internship

Selected interns will have the opportunity to:

- Assist in **legal research and comparative law studies**
- Support the work of the Commission in **law reform projects**
- Gain exposure to the **functions and operations** of the Law Commission of Sri Lanka
- Obtain a certificate on the successful completion of research with the Law Commissioners

Duration

- The internship will be for a period of 6 months (renewable)
