

## **Call for Expressions of Interest**

### **Student Volunteers for the Trilingual Legal Glossary Project, 2026**

The Faculty of Law is inviting Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from students who wish to volunteer for the preparation of a Trilingual Legal Glossary. This initiative aims to develop a legal terminology resource in English, Sinhala, and Tamil to support legal education, research, and practice. Volunteers will assist with tasks such as reviewing legal terminology, checking translations, verifying consistency, and completing other language-related assignments allocated by the project team.

This project will involve assisting with the preparation and review of legal terminology in English, Sinhala, and Tamil.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be able to work in English and either Sinhala or Tamil.
- Be able to commit approximately one hour per day to the assigned tasks throughout the project period.

A total of 20 student volunteers will be selected:

- 13 students proficient in Sinhala
- 07 students proficient in Tamil

As the number of places is limited, volunteers will be selected on a first-come, first-served basis. The names of all selected student volunteers will be acknowledged in the published Trilingual Legal Glossary in recognition of their valuable contribution to the project.
