

Compulsory Full Day Introductory Programme – Internship Programme 2026

All Third Year Undergraduates are hereby informed that they are **required to be present at the Faculty of Law on Monday, 14th September 2026, from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.** for the **Compulsory Full Day Introductory Programme** of the Internship Programme 2026.

Students are required to report to the Faculty before 9.00 a.m. and remain until the conclusion of the programme at 4.00 p.m. Attendance at both the morning and afternoon sessions is compulsory.

The programme will be conducted as follows:

Morning Session: 9.00 a.m. – 12.00 p.m.

During the morning session, students will:

- be informed of their respective internship providers;
- be grouped and allocated to Internship Supervisors from the Internship Course Team;
- be provided with opportunities for one-to-one consultations with their Supervisors to discuss the Internship Programme and raise any matters relating to their internship;
- receive guidance on the assessment procedure applicable to the Internship subject;
- be informed of the expectations, responsibilities, and standards of conduct applicable to students during the Internship Programme; and

Afternoon Session: 1.00 p.m. – 4.00 p.m.

The afternoon session will consist of the Introductory Orientation Session and Workshop of the Internship Programme.

This important orientation programme will feature the participation of **Hon. Justice Yasantha Kodagoda, PC** and **Mr. Jagath Wickramanayake, PC**, together with other distinguished members of the legal profession, who will provide valuable guidance and practical insights for students commencing their internships.

Attendance

Attendance at both the morning and afternoon sessions is **compulsory**. Attendance will be recorded separately for each session and will be closely monitored.

Students who are unable to attend either session due to an acceptable reason must inform Ms. Jayani Christina in advance, before the commencement of the relevant session, by email at jayani@law.cmb.ac.lk.

Failure to attend either session without prior notice and an acceptable reason may adversely affect the student's participation in, and compliance with, the requirements of the Internship Programme.
